Regular meetings are at 6:30 PM



ALL candidates MUST bring ALL of the following:

- 1. 2 forms of I.D. one MUST be a photo I.D.
- 2. A pencil AND a pen with blue or black ink.
- 3. The original AND a photocopy of any valid ham license.
- 4. The original AND a photocopy of any C.S.C.E.
- 5. The test fee of \$15 cash only.
- 6. Your FRN Number. (free from the FCC, call for details)

It has been a busy year with a lot of radio related events.





Skywarn Recognition Day, December 4th, 2021

The National Weather Service (NWS) declared that Skywarn Recognition Day would be scheduled for December 4th, 2021. The object of this announcement was to celebrate the contributions to public safety that are made by amateur radio operator's Skywarn Spotters during threatening weather.

As a result, amateur stations were encouraged to exchange QSO and local weather information with as many National Weather Service Stations as possible on 80, 40, 20, 15,10, 6, and 2-meter bands plus the 70-centimeter band. Contacts via repeaters were permitted. The information exchanged included call sign, signal report, QTH, name, temperature, and a one- or two-word description of the weather occurring at each site that was contacted. Multiple modes were encouraged. The NWS agreed to issue Event Certificates via their web page electronically and in printable form after the event.

Here in Western PA, amateur clubs were specifically encouraged by local ARRL and ARES representatives to volunteer by substituting for the NWS personnel because of the Federal Covid restrictions. The Beaver Valley ARA (BVARA) stepped up to the request and volunteered time, equipment, and people to support this recognition event like we did on the 100th Anniversary of Radio Station KDKA.

Jim Allan, KC3IXE, Doug Hanna, N4YKQ, Tony Pavilonis, K3AHP, and Rich Soltesz, K3SOM operated two stations on 20, 40, and 80 meters at the home of K3SOM on Saturday from 4 pm to 6 pm. The bands cooperated and noise levels were low resulting in very positive results. A total of 86 SSB contacts were made

that covered 33 states and 2 Canadian provinces. At times, extended runs of contacts and DX-like pile-ups made the brief time slot fly very quickly. We all had a good time for a good cause. It is always a unique experience to be on the other side of a pile-up!
