

- 4. The original AND a photocopy of any C.S.C.E.
- 5. The test fee of \$15 cash only.
- 6. Your FRN Number. (free from the FCC, call for details)





Did You Miss the Huge International Contest on the 10-Meter Band?

On October 25th to 26th 2025, the CQ Worldwide DX SSB Contest was held on all non-WARC HF bands. If you want to work 100 DX "Countries" (entities) on one weekend, this is **THE** event in which to seriously participate. Furthermore, this is just about the peak of Solar Cycle 25 for propagation that will begin the downward spiral for the 11-year cycle of our Sun.

Here is what the band looked like at around noon on Saturday, October 25th on my panadapter that was set to display from about 28.300 MHz to 28.900 MHz:



The yellow letters just above the graph give the spots for the call signs that are displayed. These spots have a short lifetime that will disappear if they are not re-spotted within so many minutes.

If you are a CW aficionado, the CW version is at the end of November. Go for it!
